
ABOUT OSU

- OSU is just 1 of 3 land, sea, space, and sun grant universities in the U.S.
- As of Fall 2024:
 - Total Student Enrollment 37,573 (Cascades, Corvallis, Ecampus, INTO, LaGrande, and Portland locations) 84% are Undergraduate and 16% are Graduate students
 - 26,719 Financial Aid Recipients
 - Over \$194 million accepted in loans (170M in Federal and 24M in Private) to over 13K borrowers

ALTERNATIVE /PRIVATE STUDENT LOAN PROCESS

Goals of the project:

- 1. Reduce manual certifications from 100% to 50%
- 2. Reduce manual entry errors
- 3. Reduce processing times from 3-4 weeks to 2-3 business days
- 4. Improve the student experience and transparency within the school certification process



ALTERNATIVE /PRIVATE STUDENT LOAN PROCESS

Steps in designing our process:

- Met with staff to identify their steps, any decision points, data they use, and obstacles or roadblock they encounter.
- 2. Group decision points: Data/Human Driven
- 3. Getting all necessary data into one system
- 4. Designing around simplicity


