Questions/Issues for Executive Council Feedback:

- Current OOG FAFSA/ORSAA filing date is 5/15/2026 and the SAI limit is 8,000.
- OPG will have an SAI limit for class of 2026. We are currently working on awarding and projections, and hope to announce the finalized SAI limit within the next couple of weeks.
- OTSG is anticipated to be over budget for the 2025-27 biennium. We have communicated this to the governor's office and were instructed to continue to award all eligible applicants with the plan to submit an Eboard request in December for the additional funds needed. The application deadline is September 30, 2026 for the 2026-27 aid year.
 - We will need to collect early disbursement estimates from schools in order to project how much additional funding will be required to award all eligible students for the 2026-27 aid year. We are anticipating collecting that data in early October.
- OSAC is working to bring the ORSAA in house with the 2027-28 aid year. We are planning on opening the ORSAA to mixed status families.
 - The way that OPG statute is currently written, students who are eligible to complete the FAFSA but chose to complete the ORSAA would not be eligible to receive OPG. HECC is working to incorporate a change in statute through Legislative Concept and Policy Option Package. This change would have an impact on the OPG budget as students who are eligible for Pell would receive a larger OPG award with this change. At this time, this is the only state grant that has been identified limiting eligibility for students who chose to complete the ORSAA instead of the FAFSA.
- Legislative Concepts updates:
 - HECC is not moving forward with the elimination of OPG LC.
- Kerry Thomas is continuing in the Interim OSAC director role until we are able to move forward with a search for a permanent director.
- We have heard a desire for OSAC to engage with the OASFAA community in different and more ways. What does this look like?

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
